We grow native and climate-adapted plants appropriate for the Mountain West region. To ensure survivability in harsh climates, our seed is regionally collected and all seedlings undergo rigorous hardening-off protocols.

We work with partners within the industry and private landowners. Our partners include conservation districts, government entities, nonprofits, retail wholesale nurseries, and other entities working professionally in the conservation space.

Our Structure

OneCanopy is a for-profit social enterprise wholly owned by a private foundation. As we earn, profits are reinvested back into the company to expand our impact. Our triple bottom line framework allows us to make decisions with the planet and people in mind, as well as help partners navigate their own internal red-tape.

Large-Scale Projects

OneCanopy supports landscapescale reforestation and conservation projects that involve complex governance and logistical planning. Based on project needs, partners can choose material from our speculative pallet or reach out to discuss a custom grow contract.

We work with partners to ensure appropriate seed stock, product size, price point, and logistics planning such as delivery and packaging. This includes providing trees for projects funded by the carbon market, Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, and Inflation Reduction Act.

Custom Growing

OneCanopy works with customers to identify and locate the most appropriate seed or propagation stock and container size.

Customers who provide their own seed or cuttings are eligible for discounts.

Our tailored approach allows us the flexibility to engage in small-batch projects and grow a larger variety of material, such as forbs, shrubs, and grasses. We're currently serving a variety of customers in this capacity, from federal research projects to mining reclamation to habitat improvement.

Retail Wholesale Nursery

Because we're privately funded, we're uniquely positioned to provide material to retail wholesale nurseries.

We provide native field liners, one and three gallon containers, and retail-ready seedlings.

We also provide custom growing for nursery clients when the material aligns with our conservation mission.
