

CSU Lodging Policies:

ALCOHOL AND MARIJUANA POLICY - Alcohol is not allowed in your sleeping room in the campus residence halls or in any indoor or outdoor space at the University unless offered at an official pre-approved Event. Recreational marijuana use, possession, and distribution is a violation of University Policy. These activities are illegal for persons under 21; for those 21 and older, these activities cannot occur on any University property. In addition, marijuana obtained for medicinal purposes cannot be stored or used on campus. For more information please visit:

ANIMALS/PETS - No pets are allowed in any buildings on campus including all residence halls with the exception of service animals. If you are lodging on campus and requires a service animal, you must notify CES prior to your arrival. Upon arrival, you will be required to sign a liability waiver for the animal before check-in is allowed.

Such audio, video, film, and/or print images may be edited, duplicated, distributed, reproduced, broadcast, and/or reformatted in any form and manner without payment of fees. If you do not want to be photographed, recorded, or videotaped, please indicate that in your registration.
